Fiscal Sponsorship is used primarily when a film or media-related project wants to secure funding from individual, foundation, government or corporate sources that give only to nonprofit organizations with IRS tax-exempt status. To be considered exempt, an organization must hold a current 501 (c) (3)

certificate from the IRS.

Introducing TFC Fiscal Sponsorship

Filmmakers and directors of educational media projects who reside in North America are eligible for fiscal sponsorship through DER. We cannot sponsor filmmakers outside North America. Fiscal sponsorship applications are accepted on a rolling basis. Please note that it may take as long as a month to process an application.
